On behalf of Durant Public Schools, we welcome visitors to each of our school campuses. However, the safety of students is top priority. Please review the information below regarding routines and ways that you may help us reach this goal on a daily basis!

MORNING DROP OFF

At each school site, there will be designated drop-off lanes available for parents to utilize. For the safety of your child and others, students should exit from the passenger side of the vehicle onto the sidewalk. Safety patrols will be watching students entering the building.

Beginning August 27, parents/visitors who would like to walk their child to their assigned morning wait area, may enter through the front entrance before 7:45 a.m. Visitors must check-in through the schoolSAFE ID system and receive a visitor badge. This procedure safeguards all students, faculty, and staff. All visitors should exit the building no later than 7:50 a.m., so teachers may begin morning instruction.

AFTERNOON PICK UP

The end of the school day is a very hectic time. Our goal is to ensure students are prepared for dismissal and are safely delivered to the correct location for pick-up. If you need to change your child's regular route of transportation, please call your child's main office before 1:45 p.m.
