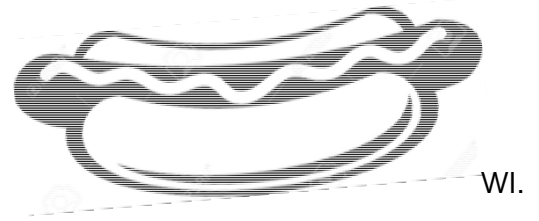

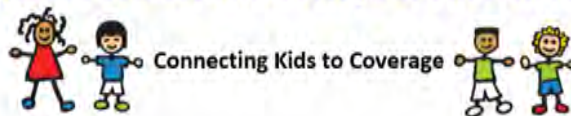
Choctaw Nation Community Outreach Benefit Coordinators will be at the Parent Teacher Conference located at Northwest Heights Elementary on:
