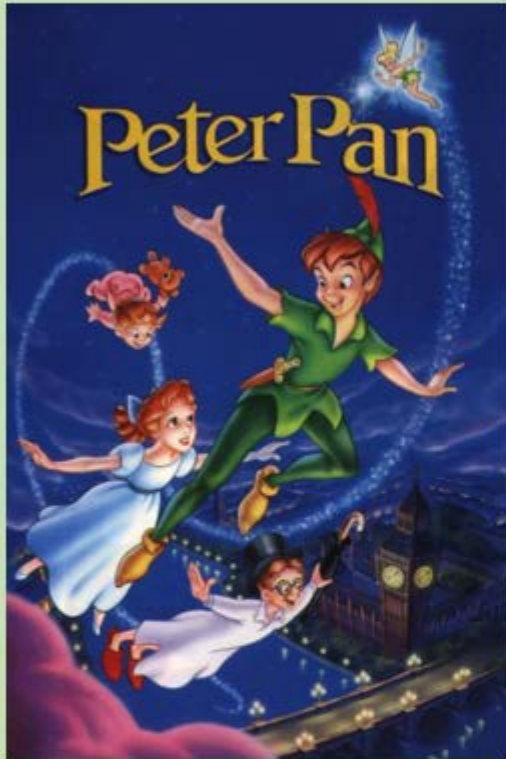

## AUDITIONS, REGISTRATION AND WORKSHOP DATES



- **Children's Theatre** is geared for ages 4-12. However, children can still participate if they are 13. We will be performing *Peter Pan* this summer.
- Children's Theatre is \$130 for the 4-week workshop and includes a t-shirt.
- Children's Theatre meets Monday through Friday from 1- 3pm. We begin Monday, 03 June and it ends Sunday, 30 June after the final performance.
- Performances are Friday, 28 June at 7pm, Saturday, 29 June at 2pm and 7pm, and Sunday, 30 June at 2pm.
- All rehearsals and performances are in Montgomery Auditorium.
- Auditions are Friday, 01 March from 1-6pm and Saturday, 02 March from 10am – noon. These auditions are COME AND GO. This means that you get to choose when you come to the auditions. You do not stay the entire time that is listed above. Once your child has completed the audition process, you are free to leave.
- Auditions are in the NEW THEATRE BUILDING which is the building between the new basketball gym and the baseball field on the campus of Southeastern Oklahoma State

University.

- For auditions, the children can either tell a joke, or they can memorize a short monologue from *Peter Pan*. They will sing a song (usually "Happy Birthday"), learn a short dance and get their picture taken. The auditions are closed, but parents will remain in the building.
