Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Bryan County Health Department will be at your child's school on Tuesday, April 12, 2022 providing Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Tdap) vaccines to 6th grade students. A Tdap vaccine is required for Oklahoma children going into 7th grade. Included in this packet, you will find a vaccine information sheet for additional information regarding Tdap vaccine.

In order for your child to be able to receive a vaccine the following forms must be completed and returned to school: PHOCIS Client Information Worksheet, Screening Checklist for Contraindications to Vaccines for Children and Teens, and a Consent for Service. Unfortunately, your child will not be immunized if the required paperwork is not completed and returned with parent/guardian signatures.

For students who have private insurance, a claim will be sent to the insurance provider. If you receive a bill, please contact the Bryan County Health Department at (580) 924-4285.

If students are not cooperative, the vaccine will not be administered. Parents/guardians are welcome to be in attendance.
